Households wanting to hand out treats should leave an outside light on for trick-or-treaters

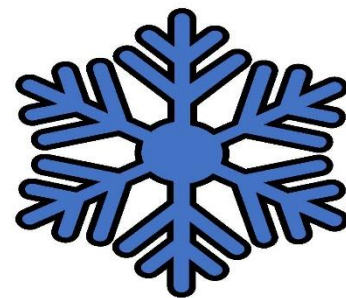
### Fall Leaf Collection

Piles of leaves can be placed on the terrace by 7am on Mondays beginning October 14<sup>th</sup> through November 18<sup>th</sup>.

Public Works will make one sweep per street per week as weather permits.

Piles that have excessive amounts of grass will NOT be picked up curbside.

Residents can also take leaves to the dumpsite located At 100 Pleasant Hill Avenue. The dumpsite is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

## How to Understand the Quarterly Water and Sewer Bill

Lomira Utility sewer and water bills are issued four times a year (quarterly) and are calculated based upon the usage at the property. Bills can fluctuate as usage and rates change. Here is a simplified explanation to understand the bill:

- The **BILLING DATE** is the date the quarterly bill is created. The **DUE DATE** is the date the full payment is due. The bill is always due the 28<sup>th</sup> day of the month following the bill date. A 3% late fee is applied to all outstanding balances after the due date.
- The **PREVIOUS** and **PRESENT READING DATES** indicate the time span of the quarterly bill.
- Listed below the reading dates are another set of numbers labeled **PREVIOUS** and **PRESENT**. The **PREVIOUS** indicates the water meter reading from the previous quarterly bill. The **PRESENT** indicates the water meter reading that was collected on the **PRESENT READING DATE**. The difference between the **PRESENT** reading and the **PREVIOUS** reading equals the total usage, which is indicated under the **USAGE** column. Customers are billed based upon the usage. In this example, the customer is billed for 17,060 gallons of usage.
- Some customers will make payments on their accounts between quarters, to build up a credit to offset the quarterly charges. This also helps customers with personal budgeting, so they don't fall behind. In this example, there is a credit balance because the resident was paying additional money on their account to offset the charges prior to the bill being processed for the quarter.
- The PFP charge is also listed on each bill. The PFP is a Public Fire Protection fee. More information can be found at [www.villageoflomira.gov/utilities-services](http://www.villageoflomira.gov/utilities-services). Businesses may also be assessed an additional private fire protection charge.
- Next, the sewer and water charges are listed. The rates for each are listed on the back of the utility bill. The amount listed includes the quarterly service charge plus the usage at the appropriate rate.
- **Due to the excess amount of water that may be used during the summer months for filling pools, watering lawns, etc., the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter sewer charge is based upon the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter usage for Residential customers, unless usage in the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter is less than the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter.** If 1<sup>st</sup> quarter usage was less than 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter usage, the sewer usage will be different (and less) than the water usage.
