

HYDRANT FLUSHING WEEK OF SEPTEMBER 28TH – OCTOBER 2ND

Public Works will be flushing hydrants approximately the week of September 28th – October 2nd from 7:30am to 4pm, depending on workload. Please be cautious of washing clothes on these days as they may be stained by rust. Drinking the water is not harmful. Please contact Public Works at 920-269-8155 with questions. Thank you.

What is the purpose of fire hydrant flushing?

The periodic “flushing” of fire hydrants is an important preventative maintenance activity that helps to ensure the integrity of the water system and to provide the highest quality water to our customers. More specifically, hydrant flushing serves the following purposes:

- Flushes sediments from water main pipes, thus enhancing water quality;
- Verifies that fire hydrants and valves are working properly, and that ample water flow is available for firefighting needs;
- Aids in determining weaknesses in water pipes and related fittings and valves.

The Village of Lomira Water Utility flushes hydrants twice a year.

To account for increased water use during the summer months, such as filling pools and watering lawns, residential sewer charges for the third quarter are based on first-quarter water consumption. However, if third-quarter water usage is lower than first-quarter usage, the lower third-quarter consumption will be used to calculate the sewer charge.

- There is a \$35 fee on all returned payments. To ensure proper financial procedures, the Village of Lomira does not honor post-dated checks. Payments are processed on the day they are received.

RATES FOR SEWER SERVICE

Sewer charges are based on water used. Minimum sewer charge per quarter is \$26.02. The charge is calculated by multiplying the total number of gallons of water used by \$12.70/1000 plus a service charge of \$26.02.

QUARTERLY UTILITY BILLS

Utility bills are due by the date printed on the bill and become delinquent on the next day after due date. Delinquent charges will be assessed in the amount of 3%. Minimum penalty is \$.50. In the event the sewer and water bill remains unpaid after due date, there will be a past due/disconnection notice. Water service reconnection fee is \$30.
