

ORDINANCE # 363  
Parks, Ponds, and Waterways

The Board of the Village of Lomira, Dodge County, Wisconsin hereby ordains Section 20-11 be amended to read as follows:

**Sec. 20-11. Park facilities.**

(a) Definitions and Hours.

(1) The term "park facilities" means all land owned and maintained by the village that is within the border lines of land designated as parks, ponds, and waterways on the official village map and all buildings and equipment thereon.

(2) Public use of any village park or village recreation property on any day shall be between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. unless otherwise posted at the property. Park facilities and equipment are used at own risk. Motorized equipment/vehicles are prohibited in all parks, with the exception of handicap mobility devices.

(b) *Exceptions.*

(1) Subsection (a) of this section shall not apply to any recognized nonprofit organization that has requested use of the park facilities for a fundraising project of their choice and have been granted permission by the Village Board

(c) *Use of facilities; permission required.* Permission for the use of the Sterr Park pavilion must be obtained from the clerk/treasurer. Permission for the use of the Lomira Athletic Field Park and Baseball Diamonds shall be obtained from the clerk/treasurer and the Lomira Athletic Association. Permission for use of the park facilities will be granted on a first come, first serve basis.

(d) *Use; responsibility of persons.* All persons receiving permission for use of park facilities will be responsible for maintaining the good conduct of all persons present, providing police supervision when needed, and cleaning up the area of the park used.

(e) *Use of park equipment.* Park equipment shall only be used in the village parks. It shall be unlawful for anyone to intentionally remove or damage park equipment or property from any village park. Climbing trees and altering plants in any way is prohibited.

(f) Ponds and waterways. The following rules shall apply to the Lomira Creek, Crystal Springs Pond, Sterr Park Pond, and Lomira "Buerger Trail" Pond:

(1) Swimming is prohibited

(2) Motorized boats prohibited, with the exception of remote-controlled toy boats

(3) Non-motorized boats, such as kayaks and canoes, are permitted at Lomira "Buerger Trail" Pond and to be used at own risk. Non-motorized boats are prohibited in all other ponds and waterways.

(4) Fishing is permitted; trapping or hunting of any kind is prohibited unless granted permission by the Administrator.

(f) *Enforcement.* Members of the police department and any such other persons as may be authorized by the village board are empowered to issue citations to any person or persons found to be in violation of any section of this Chapter.

(g) *Violation and penalty.* See section 1-8.


