

RESOLUTION # 1000

A resolution providing for the proper street names within the Village of Lomira

The Board of the Village of Lomira, Dodge County, Wisconsin hereby ordains the following:

WHEREAS, the Village of Lomira contains several streets that are identified by more than one street name; and

WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service, Dodge County and the Village of Lomira use different labels for said streets and historical information for such difference is unknown and such difference can create challenges for emergency dispatch services and mailing services; and

WHEREAS, street addresses are not duplicated on any one street within the Village and number progression proceeds south to north and east to west; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Lomira does not recognize directional terms for any of the Village streets, unless it is listed as the intended proper name;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the streets in the Village of Lomira street names shall be known as the following without indication of direction unless listed below:
