The committee discussed a sidewalk safety program. All members agreed to place a notice insert in the tax bills and fourth quarter sewer and water bills that notifies property owners of the sidewalk maintenance plan. In the spring of 2026, Public Works will mark the sidewalk areas that are not in compliance with ordinance specifications. Then, the clerk's office will follow up with a letter to the property owner. The property owner will need to make the repairs or replacement. It will be in the best interest of the property owner to make the repairs immediately. If compliance isn't met by spring 2027, the Village will take further action.
