

Tax payments for the 2023 tax year payable in 2024 can be paid by cash, check, or debit/credit card*.

*Debit/credit payments are processed by The Payment Group and can be made online at www.villageoflomira.gov/taxes or at the Clerk's office. TPG charges a convenience fee for their card service, which will be added to the total amount due.

WHERE TO PAY:

⇒ **MAIL:** Please enclose the proper portion of the bottom of your tax bill with payment. Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope to have a receipt mailed to you OR

⇒ **OUTSIDE DROP-BOX:** The dropbox is near the front entrance of the municipal building located at 425 Water Street, Lomira. Please enclose the proper portion with payment from the bottom of your tax bill. Please include a self-addressed stamped envelope to have a receipt mailed to you OR

⇒ **IN PERSON:** Payments can be brought to the Clerk's office at the municipal building located at 425 Water Street during office hours

⇒ **ONLINE:** Debit/credit card payments are processed by The Payment Group and can be made online at www.villageoflomira.gov/taxes or at the Clerk's office M-F 8am-4pm.

For payments made by mail, the receipts are **TIMELY** if they bear a **POSTMARK** on or prior to **December 31st** or **January 31st**. Anything after the 31st postmark will be credited the next business day, and in the case of January 31st, are delinquent, which will mean additional interest and penalties added to the total amount due. If you have a special assessment or delinquent utility charge added to your bill, it must be paid by January 31. **PERSONAL PROPERTY** tax bills (businesses only) must be **PAID IN FULL BY JANUARY 31st**.

All escrow tax refunds will be mailed to the taxpayer within 10 business days from receipt of the payment. Please remember to sign your escrow check before mailing it to the Village.

Office hours are Monday – Friday 8am to 4pm

**The Clerk-Treasurer's office will be closed for the Holidays on
December 25th and 26th, January 1st and 2nd**

Payments will be considered timely if they are placed in the dropbox or postmarked accordingly.



How Your Tax Dollar is Distributed



Get Your 2024 Pet Licenses!

The Village requires all dogs and cats, at least 5 months, to be licensed every year and to have a current rabies vaccine.

\$10 per pet if spayed/neutered
 \$15 per pet if not spayed/neutered

Dog and cat licenses are available at the Clerk's office or online www.villageoflomira.gov/dog-cat

Top Reasons To License Your Pet:

- It greatly improves your chance of getting your pet returned if it goes missing
- It lets people know your pet is up to date on its rabies vaccine.
- State Law and Village Ordinance require dogs and cats to be licensed.
