**MEETING MINUTES
NOVEMBER 24, 2025**

This meeting was called to order at 4pm by Chairman Jennifer Priesgen.

Attendance: Jennifer Priesgen, Gary More, Jessica Loomans

Public Attendance: Leah Henckel of the Dodge County Pionier, Jenna Rhein

The committee discussed the future of the wheel tax. They agreed to create an updated presentation of the value the wheel tax has. Gary suggested the Board discuss the continuation of the wheel tax at the December meeting.

The committee also discussed the newly implemented fee for civic and non-profit organizations using the community room at the municipal building. At the October Board meeting, the schedule of fees was updated so that civic and non-profit organizations would pay a \$25 fee to use the room. If the room was left unclean, then an additional \$50 clean-up fee would apply. This stemmed from numerous occasions when the library used the room and did not leave it clean and orderly. The committee members agreed there should be a fee to hold organizations accountable and ensure that clean-up will take place. The committee will propose a \$100 refundable fee at the beginning of each year. The fee will be refunded to the organizations prior to December 31st. If an organization does not leave the room clean and orderly according to the community room contract, then they will not receive the deposit. A new deposit will need to be paid before they will be allowed to use the room again. This will go before the Board at the December meeting.
