

ORDINANCE # 366

REGULATIONS FOR RUMMAGE/GARAGE/YARD SALES

The Board of the Village of Lomira, Dodge County, Wisconsin hereby ordains the creation of Sec.14-134 as follows:

Sec. 14-134 – Regulations for rummage/garage/yard sales.

- (a) Definitions. As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the following meanings, unless the context clearly indicates that a different meaning is intended:
 - a. Rummage/Yard/Garage Sale means the sale of new or used items from a residence. Items sold include but are not limited to household items, antiques, rare items, decorations, used books, etc.
 - b. Rummage/Yard/Garage Seller means a person selling items or offering items for sale at a rummage/yard/garage sale.
- (b) Rummage/Garage/Yard Sales shall be regulated under the following:
 - a. Sales can only be conducted between the hours of 7am and 7pm.
 - b. No sale shall last longer than four consecutive days.
 - c. Advertisement signs larger than 3'x 2' may not be placed in the right-of-way or on any traffic control signs.
 - d. Unlawful transactions. No person shall sell or offer for sale at any rummage/yard/garage sale any goods known to such person to be stolen.
- (c) Unsold/unwanted items. Items set on the property's yard, driveway, or terrace that are marked or unmarked for sale or free of charge may be placed on the property for public view for no longer than four consecutive days. If the item(s) is not sold or retrieved after four consecutive days, then it shall be the property owner's responsibility to dispose of the items properly at their expense. Items are prohibited from being placed on the yard, driveway, or terrace marked for sale or free of charge repeatedly for four consecutive days in order to promote aesthetics, order, and general welfare for the people within the village.
- (d) Violation; penalty. Any person who shall interfere with the enforcement of any of the provisions of this chapter and shall be found guilty thereof shall be subject to a penalty as provided in section 1-8.
